

Friday, October 7, 1938.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County Florida, met in Special Session on this Friday October 7, 1938 pursuant to adjournment of Monday October 3, 1938, with the following members present and participating: J. J. Sharon Chairman, G. M. Bishop, L. B. Gill, Clayton Davis and W. A. Adkison, being all the members of said Board, together with R.D. Underwood, Clerk. The following proceedings were had and done.

The Clerk reported to the Board that while in Tallahassee on Tuesday of this week, he had discussed with members of the Comptroller's office the resolution in regard to distribution of Gas Tax monies that was presented to the Board on September 30th, 1938 by Mr. M. O. Warren, and that he was advised that Harry H. Wells had spent three or four days in the Comptroller's office checking up on the manner of distribution now being followed and had made an effort to get the Comptroller to correct some alleged discrepancies in the manner of distribution of Gas Tax Money to the Counties. The Comptroller had advised him that he would correct any mistakes made in calculation but could not make corrections of discrepancies caused by a misinterpretation of the act. Mr. Wells had advised that the discrepancies were the result of misconstruction of the act and would necessitate Judicial determination and that about a dozen counties would be benefitted by the correction. Mr. Wells would not advise the nature of the discrepancy but did advise that it was so simple that all would wonder why they had not noticed it.

The Clerk reported further that he discussed this matter with the state auditor who was very much interested and that the auditor had promised a full and complete investigation.

Thereupon the Board agreed to table the resolution indefinitely.

Adkison and duly carried by a unanimous vote it was ordered that all County employees at present employed be re-employed until January 1, 1939 at the same salaries as heretofore paid, except the Janitor who is to be paid \$60.00 per month instead of \$75.00

John Penton former resident of this County appeared before the Board and asked the Board to approve his transfer from WPA rolls of another County to WPA rolls of this County, which transfer was approved by unanimous vote on motion of Com. Bishop seconded by Com. Adkison.


