


WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9, 1940

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida met in special session on this Wednesday, October 9, 1940 pursuant to the call of the Chairman with the following members present and participating, Chairman G. M. Jennings, Commissioners G. M. Bishop, L. E. Hill, M. M. Adkison and J. J. Ward being all the members of said Board together with R. B. Underwood, Clerk. The following proceedings were had and done.

The Chairman announced that this meeting had been called for the reason that it was thought that a plan had been worked out whereby the Board might help to continue WPA sewing rooms in the County. He stated that the City Council had agreed to sponsor one half the cost of sponsorship if the County would take care of the other half. He advised that it would amount to \$65.00 per month. After much discussion, upon the motion of Commissioner Ward seconded by Commissioner Adkison and duly carried by the vote of four for the motion to none against, Commissioner Bishop not voting, it was ordered that the Board would contribute to-ward the costs of sponsoring the Sewing Room and House Keeping Aide Projects in this County for the months of October, November and December in the amount of \$65.00 each month for the three months,

The Board thereupon adjourned to meet on Tuesday, October 15, 1940.
