

The Board met in adjourned session on this September 29th. 1945, pursuant to adjournment of September 7th. 1945, with the following members present and participating, Chairman L. E. Gill, Commissioners, M. C. Burke, James Padgett, M. M. Adkison and Hiltz Crook, being all the members of said Board, together with Kate Gillis, Clerk. The following proceedings were had and done:-

The Board considered all bills on file against the various County funds and those found correct and legally due were ordered approved and warrants drawn therefor upon motion of Comr. Burke, seconded by Comr. Adkison and duly carried by the unanimous vote of all, as follows: From the General Revenue Fund \$2293.30; From Fine and Forfeiture Fund: \$1953.80; From Road and Bridge Fund \$4830.31. Jail Report for September filed.

Card received from J. E. McKeenan received complaining about the condition of the 3 bridges across the Bay near Santa Rosa.

The Board examined a Plat of Kam-Acres submitted by J. C. O'Connell and it appearing to have been filed in accordance with law, the Board ordered same filed as approved on motion of Comr. Crook, seconded by Comr. Padgett and duly carried by the unanimous vote of all.

Application for Caterpillar tractor returned as this was no longer required.

The following application and bond for duplicate Tax Sale Certificate was submitted and approved by the Board on the motion of Commissioner Padgett, seconded by Comr. Burke and duly carried by the unanimous vote of all, to-wit:

(3) That said Tax Sale Certificate has been lost or destroyed and that I have made diligent search and am unable to locate said certificate.

(4) That if duplicate Certificate is issued, in lieu thereof and the original should at any time be located, the same will be surrendered to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Walton County for cancellation.

(5) That I, T. G. Jones, as a further consideration acknowledge myself held and firmly bound unto Kate Gillis, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Walton County, and her successors in office in the sum of \$33.60 being double the amount of the face of said Tax Certificate, for payment whereof well and truly to be made, I bind myself, heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents should said certificate be presented by any person whomsoever, assigned or otherwise, for payment or application for Tax Deed thereon.

I solemnly swear, or affirm, that the statements contained herein in support of my application for issuance of duplicate Tax Sale Certificate, are true and correct. So help me God.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WALTON COUNTY, ASKING AUTHORITY  
TO TRANSFER FUNDS IN 1944-1945 BUDGET.

WHEREAS in making up the 1944-1945 Budget there were certain miscalculations made as to the expenses of the County chargeable to items in the General Revenue Fund and in the Court House Bond Interest and Sinking Fund, resulting in deficits in certain items and surpluses in certain items:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that the Comptroller be and he is hereby requested to authorize this Board to make the following transfers in the General Revenue Fund in order to take care of the deficits therein at this time:

In the Court House Bond, Interest and Sinking Fund:

To pay commissions to paying agents	\$ 25.76	From Interest and Sinking Fund.
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and with the approval of this Resolution by the Comptroller that the Clerk of this Board be and she is hereby authorized to make the proper entries in the records of her office.

There being no further business the Board adjourned to meet in Regular Session on Tuesday, October 9th. 1945, unless sooner called in session by the Chairman.
