

SPECIAL MEETING, FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 8TH. 1946.

The Board of County Commissioners met on this Friday, November 8th. 1946, pursuant to adjournment of Monday, November 4th. 1946, with the following members present and participating:- Chairman L. E. Gill, Commissioners, M. C. Burke, James Padgett and Hiltz Crook, being all of the members of said Board, except M. M. Adkison, together with Kate Gillis, Clerk.

The following proceedings were had and done.

C. M. Bearden appeared before the Board and discussed with the Board about the right-of-way in front of his house. Mr. Bearden stated that he had executed a Deed to the State Road Department for one hundred (100) feet right of way but that it was not used at this time.

The Board advised Mr. Bearden that they would give him an answer when they met on Thursday, November 14th. 1946.

The bills that were carried over in the Road and Bridge Fund from last year's Budget were approved and warrants ordered issued therefor upon motion of Commissioner Padgett, seconded by Commissioner Burke and duly carried by all members present:

From the Road and Bridge Fund .

The Board was advised that the County Road leading into Reddick's Fish Camp had been closed up by Edgar Bozeman.

Mr. Beasley was present and stated to the Board that he had advised Mr. Bozeman not to close the road and Mr. Bozeman advised him that he would not.

Upon motion of Commissioner Crook, it was ordered that the Sheriff advise Mr. Bozeman to open up the road and if he does not do so within twenty-four (24) hours, have Warrant issued for his arrest.

County Agent's monthly report for October was filed.


