

REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13TH, 1949

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Regular Session on this, Tuesday, December 13th, 1949, with the following members present and participating: Chairman: L. E. Gill, Commissioners, M. C. Burke, H. A. Bodiford, Newton Hinote, and J. D. Sharon, being all the members of said Board, together with Kate Gillis, Clerk.

The following proceedings were had and done:

The Board considered all bills on file against the various County Funds and those that were found legally due and correct were ordered paid and warrants drawn therefor upon motion of Commissioner, M. C. Burke, seconded by Commissioner, Newton Hinote, and duly carried by the unanimous vote of all, as follows, to-wit:

H. M. Watson, et al., presented a Plat of Barbarosa Beach, a Subdivision of part of Lot Three (3), Section Twelve (12), Township Three (3) South, Range Twenty (20) West, Walton County, Florida, for filing.

Upon motion of Commissioner, J. D. Sharon, seconded by Commissioner, M. C. Burke, and duly carried by the unanimous vote of all, it was ordered that this Plat be filed in the Clerk's Office according to law.

Telegram to the Board of County Commissioners from the President of the County Commissioners Association, and the County Attorney's Association, and Chairman of State Road Department, with reference to a Meeting to be held on Thursday, December 15th in Tallahassee for the purpose of discussing a Proposed Secondary Road Plan of Florida involving the Seventh Cent Gas Tax, was read, but no action taken.

The Board received a letter from the State Tuberculosis Sanatorium, Marianna, Florida stating that Walton County's patient, Susie Henderson, had left the hospital of her own accord on November 5th, 1949, and against the advice of her physician.

The Board received a letter from the State Tuberculosis Sanitorium about the hospitalization cost of Mrs. Essie Free. The Board agreed to pay \$37.50 to apply on this cost and advised the Sanitorium that this would be the only check that it would be able to send for Mrs. Free's hospital bill.

The Board discussed the need of hard surfacing and repairing the driveways around the Walton County Hospital, and upon motion of Commissioner Bodiford, seconded by Commissioner Burke, and duly carried by the unanimous vote of all the members present, the following Resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the drive-ways around the Walton County Hospital are in need of hard surfacing and repairing and

WHEREAS, the said Walton County Hospital is used generally by the public of Walton County, and there is considerable traffic over said drive-ways

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida in regular session assembled that the State Road Department use from Walton County's portion of the second gas tax the necessary amount of funds to repair and black-top the drive-ways around the Walton County Hospital.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Honorable Alfred A. McKethan, Chairman of the State Road Department, Tallahassee, Florida and a copy to the State Road Department at Chipley, Florida and that a copy of same is spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida.

Adopted in regular session of the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida December 13, 1949.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned to meet Thursday, December 22nd. 1949.
