

ORDINANCE
1970-02

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, has been informed of the unsanitary conditions being created by persona bringing into Walton County garbage and refuse from other areas, and,

WHEREAS, the dumping of this garbage arid refuse is creating a hardship and financial burden on Walton County, and,

WHEREAS, in the view of the Board of County Commissioners said condition has created an emergency, and the immediate enactment of the ordinance is necessary and that notice be waived by four-fifths (4/5) vote, and,

WHEREAS, the prohibition of dumping of out—of—county garbage and making the violation of said ordinance a misdemeanor, would be of benefit to the citizens of Walton County, Florida,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that the dumping of out—of—county garbage and other refuse in Walton County garbage pits and sanitary land fills be and the same is hereby prohibited.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that violation of the above provisions shall be punishable as a misdemeanor.
