

ORDINANCE
1970-03

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously adopted a resolution a Resolution and ordinance regulating the speed of traffic on the public beaches of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the enactment of this ordinance the board has received numerous complaints about the traffic on the public beaches of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, feels that said traffic presents a hazard to the safety of the public use of these beaches, and

WHEREAS, a confinement of motor vehicles to certain areas of the public beaches in Walton County, Florida, would be of benefit to all citizens of Walton County, Florida,


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners feels that the existing condition has created an emergency, and

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida that motor vehicle traffic on the public beaches of Walton County, Florida, is confined to the following areas:


1. 250 feet either side the extreme South end of SR 393, that is where SR 393 terminates at the Gulf at Mexico.
2. 500 feet West of where SR 83 terminates at the Gulf of Mexico
3. 100 feet West of Grayton Beach State Park.
4. 250 feet either side of the existing county part presently located at the joiner of Section 23 and 24, Township 3 South, Range 19 West, also being approximately one (1) mile East of Seagrove Beach.
5. 500 feet along the gulf beach, at a point approximately 1,000 feet East of Eastern Lake, in Walton County, Florida.


BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED that in view of the emergency existing this ordinance be enacted without public notice and take effect immediately.
