

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County has been advised, pursuant to Attorney General's opinion #071-145A, dated June 30, 1971, that the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners may receive personal income from the Board of County Commissioners for special services rendered to the Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners feels that the Clerk does render such special services to the Board, far in excess of his statutory duties, that have not been compensated in the past, and


WHEREAS, the Board feels that he is entitled to receive such income beginning with the budget year 1970-71, and

WHEREAS, in view of the above the Board feels that an emergency exists and an ordinance should be enacted immediately, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners voted unanimously to enact such ordinance,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners to instruct the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners that he be entitled beginning with the budget year 1970-71, to receive as personal income for special services rendered to the Board, up to 80% of the present remuneration to the Clerk for such services.
