

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

**1971-03**

**WHEREAS**, on May 12, 1970, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida enacted an Emergency Ordinance requiring all improvements to be set back from property line on Federal Highways at least 100 feet from the center line of said highway, and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the passage of said Emergency Ordinance certain inequities have resulted, and


**WHEREAS**, such inequity has occurred on property herein after described, and

**WHEREAS**, in the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, the situation created constitutes an emergency and the Board having waived the regular procedure by unanimous consent,


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida that all land lying South of US, Highway 98, in Sections 30, 32 and 33, lying West of the International Beach House, to the Walton — Okaloosa County line, he and said land is hereby exempt from the provision of the Ordinance herein referred to dated May 12, 1970.
