ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, has determined that minimum floor elevation standards are required in those areas of the County where windstorm and flood insurance is to be procured, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that all of the land area in Walton County located South of Choctawhatchee Bay and the Intercoastal Waterway is in need of this protection, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County has determined that five feet above mean tide would qualify Walton County for this insurance,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that all buildings constructed South of the Choctawhatchee Bay and the Intercoastal Waterway in Walton County, Florida, be required to have a minimum floor elevation of five feet above the mean tide, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable as provided for by law.
