

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida has been advised, pursuant to Attorney General's Opinion #071-145A dated June 30, 1971, that the Clerk of the Circuit Court may receive personal income from the Board of County Commissioners for special services rendered to the Board, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Walton County acts as contracting officer for the County on all R, C & D projects, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Walton County acts as supervisor of custodial personnel and maintenance of all County property, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that these services are special services to the Board in addition to those provided by statute, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that he is entitled to special compensation for those services, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that this item constitutes an emergency in view of the fact that the annual budget must be prepared and submitted immediately,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida to instruct the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Walton County, Florida that in view of these special services as enumerated above he be entitled, beginning with the budget year 1972 - 1973, to receive as personal income for those special services the sum of \$400.00 per month.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a certified copy of this Ordinance be furnished to the Department of State as soon as practicable.
