WHEREAS, certain overloaded vehicles are causing excessive damage to County roads in Walton County, Florida, and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, feels that the load limit of 25,000 pounds should be enforced on all County roads in Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, violators should be prosecuted for exceeding said load limit,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that the gross weight of any vehicle on County roads in Walton County, Florida, be limited to 25,000 pounds.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.


