

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida has determined that septic tanks to be constructed and put into use in Walton County must be inspected by the County Sanitation Officer pursuant to Division of Health Regulations and

WHEREAS, The Board feels that this is essential to public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Walton County; and


WHEREAS, The requirement of a permit before installation of a septic tank would facilitate inspection; and

WHEREAS, A \$15.00 fee for said permit would defray expenses of inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County that a permit shall be required prior to construction of all septic tanks located in Walton County, from the County sanitation officer and that a \$15.00 fee be charged for said permit. It is further required that each septic tank be inspected before covering and being put into use.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.
