

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**  
**1973-02**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, has received increasing requests for the abandonment of certain streets and other public roadways in Walton County, Florida, and

**WHEREAS**, the administration of these requests has placed an increased burden both time-wise and financial-wise on the Board of County Commissioners, and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners feels that a service charge in the amount of THIRTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) to cover these costs would be in the benefit of the people of Walton County, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, considers this measure to be an emergency and has passed said ordinance by a unanimous vote of five to zero,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, to require a service charge of THIRTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) to accompany any petition presented to the Board to initiate closing roads or alleys in Walton County, Florida.
