

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, on May 26, 1970, passed an Ordinance No. 70-3 which provided for the regulation of motor vehicle traffic on the public beaches in Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board, due to opinion expressed at a public meeting, feels that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Walton County for Ordinance 70-3 to be rescinded, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, feel that a ten (10) mile per hour speed limit on motor vehicle traffic along the public beaches of Walton County, Florida, would be in the best interest of the citizens of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that the adoption of this measure should be accomplished as soon as possible, and

WHEREAS, the emergency ordinance was passed by unanimous vote,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, to rescind Ordinance No. 70-3 and to establish a ten (10) mile per hour speedlimit on motor vehicle traffic along the public beaches of Walton County, Florida.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.
