

AMENDMENT TO EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of August, 1974, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, adopted an Emergency Ordinance relating to motor vehicular traffic along the beaches in Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board intended to limit the effective time of the permits to two years, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels this amendment would be in the best interests of the citizens of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that this amendment constitutes an emergency which should be acted upon immediately,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that the Emergency Ordinance dated August 13,, 1974, relating to motor vehicular traffic along the beaches in Walton County, Florida, be amended to include Paragraph 14, which shall read as follows:

Paragraph 14: All permits issued shall be for a period of two years.

All other provisions of the Emergency Ordinance dated August 13, 1974 shall remain in full force and effect.
