

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, has been requested by the Department of Community Affairs to pass an Emergency Ordinance adopting the Southern Standard Builders Code as an interim measure until such time as the County Master Plan or some other building code has been adopted, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that the adoption of such an ordinance would be in compliance with the law and be of benefit to the people of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that this matter constitutes an emergency and has unanimously approved this adoption, and

WHEREAS, all construction as prescribed in the Southern Standard Builders Code in Walton County must now be in compliance with said Code, and

WHEREAS, violation of said ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that the Southern Standard Builders Code be adopted as the building code for Walton County until further action by said Board of County Commissioners.

Violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.
