

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Florida amended Florida Statute 553.80(4) to provide for certain exemptions from the State Minimum Building Codes, and

WHEREAS, 553.80(4)(a) provides an exemption as follows:

Addition, alteration, or repairs performed by the property owner upon his own property; provided, however, any addition or alteration shall not exceed 1,000 square feet, or the square footage of the primary structure, whichever is less,

and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, feels the adoption of 553.80(4)(a) would be in the best interest of the citizens of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, feels this exemption should be adopted on an emergency basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, to adopt for Walton County the provision of Florida Statutes 553.80(4)(a).

This ordinance shall take effect as of the date hereof.
