

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, was previously requested by the Department of Community Affairs to pass an Emergency Ordinance adopting the Southern Standard Building Code as an interim measure until such time as the County Master Plan, or another appropriate building code had been adopted, and

WHEREAS, Emergency Ordinance 75-1, as adopted by the Board on February 25, 1975, accomplished this measure; and

WHEREAS, the Board now feels that the fee schedule as promulgated in Section 107.4, Southern Standard Building Code, is inequitable in certain cases, and

WHEREAS, the amendment of this provision would benefit the citizens of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, this amendment constitutes an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that Section 107.4 of the Southern Standard Building Code, be amended as follows:

D. VARIANCE

Notwithstanding the schedule of fees in paragraphs A., B., and C., above, a permit shall be obtained for the sum of \$1 by the following:

- (a) All non profit organizations.
- (b) All applicants with incomes as established by the CSA Poverty Guidelines:

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Non Farm Family</u>	<u>Farm Family</u>
1	\$ 2,800	\$ 2,400
2	3,700	3,160
3	4,600	3,920
4	5,500	4,680
5	6,400	5,440
6	7,300	6,200

For family units with more than six (6) members, add \$900 for each additional member in non farm families and \$760 for each additional member in a farm family.

- (c) The Board of County Commissioners may grant further variances and allow a permit for the sum of \$1 in those cases where a majority

of the Board feel that the fees required in
A., B., and C., above would result in extreme
hardship.
