

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY OF THE WALTON COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the use and consumption of alcoholic beverages on the school campuses of our county is contrary to the health, welfare and well being of students attempting to engage in the learning process, and

WHEREAS, the presence of alcoholic beverages on school campuses of the Walton County School District is found to create a disruptive atmosphere and hazard to the learning environment of our schools,

WHEREAS, the prohibition of the use and consumption of alcoholic beverages as aforesaid will benefit the citizens of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds the present situation constitutes an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that it shall be unlawful for any person to bring upon any portion of school property of the Walton County School District any alcoholic beverage of any nature.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable under the provisions of Section 125.69 Florida Statute.

This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
