

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the ambulance service employees of Walton County, Florida, are presently incurring expenses over and above their salaries for uniforms, telephone, gasoline and other automobile expenses, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, feels that said employees should be compensated for these expenses, and

WHEREAS, the employees are rendering a valuable service to the citizens of Walton County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the 1979-80 budget year has commenced and in order for said compensation to commence immediately, it is necessary that the Board declare this to be an emergency ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month per employee will adequately reimburse the ambulance service employees for said expenses,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that each ambulance service employee of Walton County receive the sum of \$50 per month as reimbursement for expenses incurred over and above their salaries, for uniforms, telephone, gasoline, and other automobile expenses.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this emergency ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
