2007-18**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF WALTON  
COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE  
2007-05 WHICH PROHIBITED OPEN BURNING  
WITHOUT A PERMIT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, Walton County has received sufficient rainfall in recent weeks that drought conditions no longer exist in the county; and


WHEREAS, emergency conditions no longer exist which warrant the prohibition of open burning; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it to be in the health and welfare of the people of Walton County to repeal Ordinance 2007-05, hereby rescinding the emergency prohibition on open burning.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County that Ordinance 2007-05 is hereby repealed. This
