

**ORDINANCE
2007-40**

**AN ORDINANCE OF WALTON COUNTY, FLORIDA,
REPEALING WALTON COUNTY ORDINANCES 83-8, 84-
10 AND 89-1; DECLARING THE UNITED FIRE DISTRICT
TO BE DISSOLVED; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County created the United Fire District as an independent special district by enacting Walton County Ordinance 83-8, as amended by Walton County Ordinances 84-10 and 89-1; and

WHEREAS, the United Fire District has become inactive and its functions have been assumed by Walton County; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Community Affairs has, pursuant to §189.4044, Florida Statutes, changed the status of the United Fire District from “active” to “inactive;” and


WHEREAS, Walton County is authorized, under §§ 189.4042 and 189.4044, Florida Statutes, to dissolve special districts it has created; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County finds that dissolving the United Fire District is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Walton County.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that:

1. Walton County Ordinance 83-8, 84-10 and 89-1 are hereby repealed.
2. The United Fire District is hereby dissolved.
3. A copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Florida Department of Community Affairs.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
