

**ORDINANCE 2024- 15**

AN ORDINANCE OF WALTON COUNTY, FLORIDA  
REPEALING WALTON COUNTY ORDINANCES 1981-09,  
1986-19, AND 1990-10; DISSOLVING THE MOSSY  
HEAD/OAKWOOD HILLS FIRE DISTRICT; AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Walton County Board of County Commissioners (the “County”) created the Mossy Head/Oakwood Hills Fire District as a special fire district by enacting Walton County Ordinances;

**WHEREAS**, the Mossy Head/Oakwood Hills Fire District has become inactive and its functions have been assumed by the County;

**WHEREAS**, the County is authorized, under Secs. 189.071, Florida Statutes, to dissolve special districts it has created; and

**WHEREAS**, the Walton County Board of County Commissioners finds dissolving the Mossy Head/Oakwood Hills Fire District is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Walton County.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Walton County Board of County Commissioners, that:

1. Walton County Ordinances 1981-09, 1986-19, and 1990-10 are hereby repealed.
2. The Mossy Head/Oakwood Hills Fire District is hereby dissolved.
3. A copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Florida Department of Commerce, Special District Accountability Program, 107 East Madison Street, MSC-160, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2100.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
