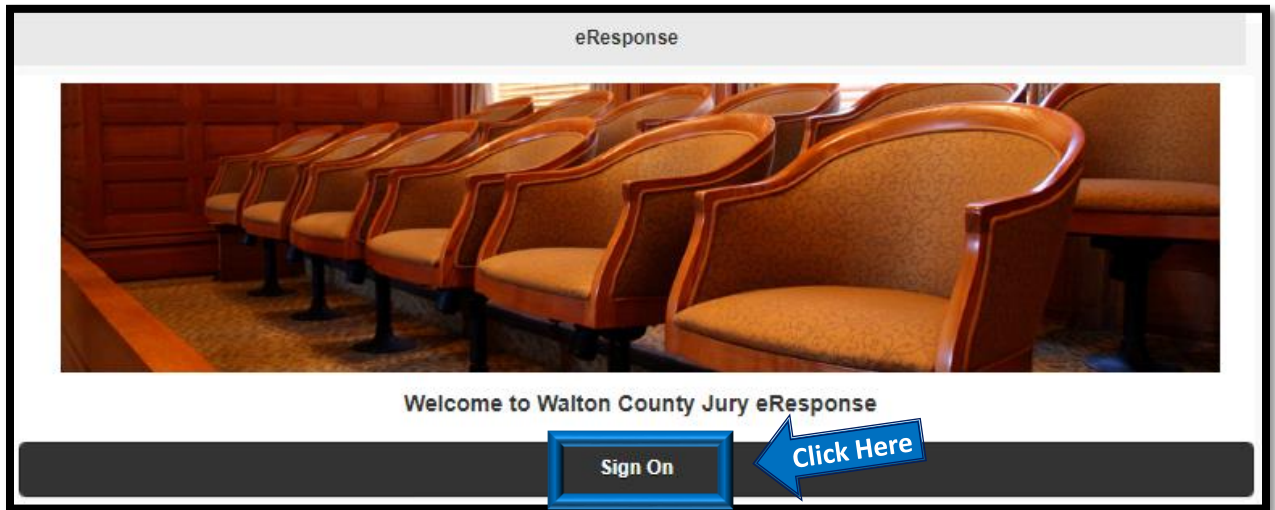




How to Request a Juror Deferment, Excusal, or Disqualification

Walton County Clerk of Court's and County Comptroller

Step 1: Visit the [eResponse Website](#) and click Sign On.



Step 2: Sign In

Enter the juror ID (found on your summons), zip code, and date of birth. Click Log In.

Step 3: Enter your Email and Phone Number

If it is your first time logging in, you will be asked to enter your email and cellphone number and click Continue. This is needed to alert you if your excusal is denied or if the jury date is cancelled and your service is no longer required.

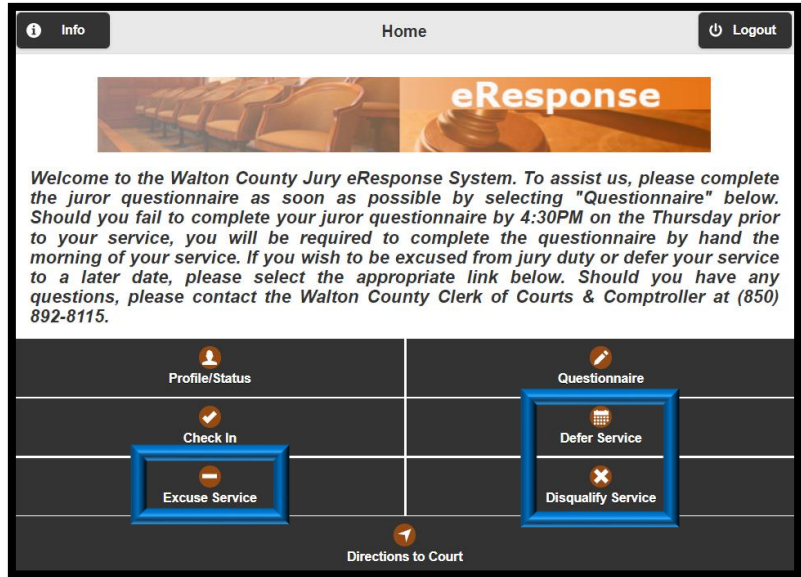

Step 5: Click Defer, Excuse, or Disqualify Service

Depending on the reason you may need to click either Defer Service, Excuse Service, or Disqualify Service. See the lists below. Defer Service allows you to request to serve at a later date instead of the one you were summonsed for. **(If clicking Defer Service, skip to Step 7.)**



Excuse Service
1. Over 70 Years of Age
2. Expectant Mother or Parent Who is Not Employed Full-Time and Have Custody of a Child Under 6 Years of Age
3. A Full-Time Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or Investigator Employed by a Law Enforcement Agency and Have the Authority to Bear Arm
4. Currently Under Prosecution for a Crime
5. Other
6. Served as a Juror Within One (1) Year in Walton County
7. Doctors Excuse
8. Undue Financial Hardship or Extreme Inconvenience
9. Take Care of a Person Who Is Incapacitated Mentally or Physically
10. Full Time Student
11. Vacation
12. Business Trip

Disqualify Service
1. Convicted Felon and Your Civil Rights Have Not Been Restored
2. Deceased
3. Currently Under Prosecution for a Crime
4. 70 Years of Age or Older Permanently Excused
5. No Longer Reside in Walton County
6. Person Who Was Previously Summoned, and Reported as a Prospective Juror in Walton County Within One (1) Year of the Reporting Date of This Summons
7. Permanently Disable Due to Mental Illness, Intellectual Disability Senility, or Other Physical or Mental Incapacity.

Step 6: Excuse and Disqualify

Click the drop down and select a reason. You may enter supporting notes in the space provided. Click Save when you are done.
